

REVIEW AND RETAIN ATTENTION: INSURED SAVINGS ACCOUNT (“ISA[®]”) PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS

Effective on or before Feb. 10, 2016 (“Effective Date”), we are making important changes to the Priority Lists of depository institutions participating in the Insured Savings Account (“ISA[®]”) program. This notice describes the changes we are making to the Priority Lists and includes a list of all depository institutions participating in the ISA program as of the Effective Date, as well as an updated Priority List for each ISA region.

Change in the sequence of depository institutions on the Priority Lists

As of the Effective Date, the sequence of depository institutions on the Priority Lists for all ISA regions will change. Beginning on the Effective Date, your funds will be deposited at participating depository institutions in a different order than the order in which your funds are currently deposited. This change in the sequence of participating depository institutions will not impact your existing ISA program deposits. Funds currently on deposit at participating depository institutions will not be reallocated based on the new sequence, but future deposits will be made in accordance with the new sequence. Your funds at participating depository institutions will continue to earn interest without interruption. Withdrawals will continue to be made in reverse priority order from the depository institutions on the updated Priority List for your ISA region, beginning with the last depository institution on the updated Priority List for your ISA region in which you have deposits.

The Priority Lists on the following pages reflect the new sequence of depository institutions. You should review the updated Priority List for your ISA region carefully. If you wish to designate any of the depository institutions on the updated Priority List as ineligible to receive your funds, please contact your financial advisor.

The following depository institutions are currently participating in the ISA program. At any given time, however, some may not be accepting new deposits.
